Dr. Brendan Hanley, Yukon's Chief Medical Officer provided an update today on the COVID19 situation in Yukon.

There are still no COVID 19 cases identified in Yukon and test results are being returned from BC more quickly.

Yukon is setting up a respiratory assessment centre in Whitehorse for people with acute respiratory illness such as influenza or COVID-19 who need medical assessment. More details are provided in the press release below.
