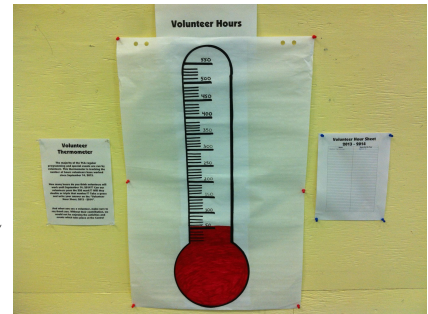

Come to the Rec. Hall on **Fridays from 10:30 AM—12:00 PM** to partake in these **parent-directed** sessions.

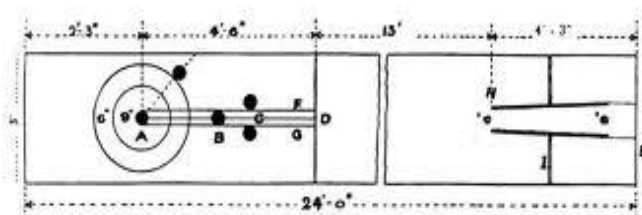


CARPET BOWLING

Youth Employment Opportunities

The TCA has been provided funding by the Yukon Government through the Youth Leadership and Activities Program (YLAP) for the following youth employment opportunities: youth rink coordinator and outdoor winter maintenance workers. The TCA is currently recruiting youth (25 years of age or younger) for both opportunities.

For the Youth Rink Coordinator, duties include organizing events that involve the outdoor rink and other outdoor facilities at the Centre, coordinating the efforts of the outdoor winter maintenance workers, and working in coordination with the Recreation Director. Skills required for this position are excellent organization, good time management, and strong leadership. This position runs from October 22, 2013 until March 31st, 2014, there are around 7 hours per week, and pay is \$14.00 per hour.

For the Outdoor Winter Maintenance Worker, duties include shoveling rink and other areas, help with ice maintenance, tidying the skate shack, assisting the Youth Rink Coordinator with events, and working in coordination with the Youth Rink Coordinator. Skills required for this position are good teamwork, excellent cooperation, and good dedication. These positions run from Oct. 22, 2013 until March 31st, 2014, there are around 5 hours per week, and the pay is \$12.00 per hour.
