



Foot & Wellness Clinic




Wednesday March 19th, 1:30-3:30 PM

SINGLE STAMP: Stamps purchased individually, will cost \$1.00 each for letters, 0-30 grams, mailed within Canada.

BOOKLETS & COILS: Stamps purchased in booklets and/or coils will cost 85 cents for letters, 0 – 35 gm, mailed within Canada.

OTHER PRODUCTS: U.S. International and oversized Lettermail and mail over 30 gm will also increase and will typically fall in line with the new established pricing levels.
