TAGISH CONTRACTORS

The Tagish Community Association is seeking a contractor to undertake interior renovations in the Community Centre.

The work consists of removing a window; framing and walling in three separate spaces, approximately 36"x80", 42"x96", and 8'x7'; installation of 2 standard interior doors and one bifold door and the installation of a set of shelves.

Some electrical and ducting work is required to make the other work possible but this is not part of the contract. The TCA will be responsible for obtaining the appropriate building permits. Bids should reflect finished work and the use of new materials'. The preparatory work will be completed by early January and it is the hope that the renovations can be completed during the week of January 5, 2015 when the Centre will be closed to the public.

Bids can be emailed to recreation@tagishyukon.org or dropped off at the Community Centre during open hours. Bids must be received no later than 4pm on Friday December 12.
